JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Sucha Singh was engaged as a driver on work charge basis on 01.06.1978 and his services were regularized on 01.07.1982 with the erstwhile P.S.E.B. The petitioner retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.01.2007 by the succeeding employer i.e. Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (P.S.P.C.L.).

Now after delay of eight and half years from the day of retirement of the petitioner, he has filed the present petition, claiming that his pay at the time of regularization on 01.07.1982, was wrongly fixed as Rs. 440/- per month, while claiming parity with the pay of his junior Shri Surinderjit Singh, similarly placed driver, fixed as Rs. 480/- He, thus, claims all successive enhancements and arrears, as also revised pension after such huge unexplained delay.

After arguing for some time and having failed to convince the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition.

In view of above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
