JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is working as an Auditor with the Punjab Roadways and is claiming promotion to the next higher post of Superintendent, which is stated to be lying vacant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner belongs to the Scheduled Caste category and fulfills the prescribed qualification of promotion to the post of Superintendent, which as per roster point would fall to the category of a Scheduled Caste candidate. He further submits that the respondents are not filling up the post for reasons best known to them. Petitioner is claiming to have filed appeals, representations (P-5 and P-6) pending since last one year.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner at length, no case for interference is made out. There is no law which permits a

mandamus to be issued to an employer for filling up a vacant post. The

petitioner has been unable to show that any person junior to him has been promoted so as to compel this court for issuance of such direction.

Dismissed.
