DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside order dated 19.12.2012 (Annexure P-4), vide which, the claim of the petitioners for promotion as Principal in Punjab Educational Services (School and Inspection) Grade 'A' has been rejected, whereas, junior to the petitioners have already been working since 15.2.2010. A further prayer has also been made for issuing directions to the respondents to promote the petitioners as Principal from the date their juniors have been promoted.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that reply in

this case is not necessary as C.W.P. No. 5059 of 2011 along with other

connected matters has already been disposed of by this Court vide order dated 27.5.2015 with certain directions, which are as under:-

“In the wake of the position as set out above, learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that let these petitions be disposed of in terms of the affidavit, dated 27.05.2015, of the Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab. It is conceded by all the learned counsel, that the parties to the lis shall abide by the assurance/undertaking/terms of the affidavit dated 27.05.2015. None has expressed any disagreement to the suggested course. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that after a final decision is reached by the Government by 30.09.2015 as regards the seniority list dated 07.03.2011, consequential promotions or reversions, if any, shall be effected within a further period of two months thereafter.

That being so, these petitions are disposed of strictly in terms of the duly sworn affidavit of Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, Department of School Education, dated 27.05.2015. Needless to assert, the respondent department shall strictly adhere to the process that has been suggested in the affidavit and would abide by the designated time schedule.”

In view of the directions issued by this Court in C.W.P. No. 5059 of 2011 as well as other connected cases, the present petition is disposed of in terms of order passed in C.W.P. No. 5059 of 2011 on 27.5.2015.
