(1) This order shall dispose of CWP Nos.10513, 14238, 16062 & 24917 of 2014; 15809, 15970, 15925, 16000 of 2015 as common issues are involved.

(2) The petitioner(s) lay challenge to the notifications 12.03.2013 & 10.03.2014 issued under Section 4&6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (in short, 'the 1894 Act') whereby their lands were proposed to be acquired for the public purpose of State Level Sports Stadium, Sector 2, Jhajjar.

(3) Learned State counsel has filed an affidavit dated 20.09.2016 of Sunita Verma, HCS, Additional Director, Urban Estate, Rohtak in CWP No.14238 of 2014 to the effect that the State Government has dropped the acquisition initiated for development and utilization of land as Open Space for Sports Stadium Sector-2, Jhajjar and consequently, the acquisition *qua*

lands of the petitioners has been dropped now, rendering the above-captioned writ petitions as infructuous.
