Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner was engaged as Sweeper on daily wage basis under the Haryana State Transport Department.

Claim in the instant petition is for grant of benefit of regularization in service with effect from the date her alleged junior, namely, Suresh Kumar has been granted such benefit. Counsel would go a step further and would contend that the petitioner is the senior most Safai Karmchari in the respondent/department and is vested with a right to be considered for regularization under the instructions issued by the State Government on 20.06.2014 at Annexure P-7.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with the directions to respondent No.3/competent authority to look into the claim of the petitioner strictly in accordance with law and to take a final decision on the representation dated 29.10.2014 (Annexure P-8) by passing a well reasoned speaking order

within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
