The present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of charge sheet dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-5) by raising certain grounds that the *mala fide* of the respondents is clear from the fact that the order of retirement has been passed on 28.07.2016, whereas, the petitioner was to retire on 31.07.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, he was not involved in any manner. Petitioner has also submitted reply to the charge sheet but the same has not been considered and no action has been taken thereupon so far. Moreover, no charges were made out as there was no evidence against the petitioner before the authorities.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the charge sheet as well as other documents available on

the file.

The petitioner has submitted reply to the charge sheet and the same is under consideration. It cannot be said at this stage as to whether the petitioner is involved or not. The respondent authorities are expected to go through the reply to the charge sheet and take further action in the matter thereafter.

Accordingly, at this stage, no ground is made out to interfere with the matter. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
