The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a Writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to transfer Dwelling Unit No. 419/2, MIG Category, Sector 45-A, Chandigarh in the name of petitioner on the basis of will dated 31.07.1992 (*Annexure P-1*).

2. Learned counsel for the respondent states that the property in dispute i.e. Dwelling Unit No. 419-2, Category III, Sector 45, Chandigarh has been transferred in the name of the Bimla Nagpal-petitioner. He has produced the original transfer order dated 19.09.2016 which has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner and photocopy of the same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Ms. Mandeep Kaur, Dealing Assistant, Chandigarh Housing Board, states that for the delay in the transferring of the aforementioned dwelling unit,

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inquiry has been marked and appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.

4. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
