The petitioners who are serving on the post of Pharmacists in the Department of Health, State of Haryana have filed the instant petition praying for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents not to reduce their grade pay from Rs.4200/- to Rs.4000/-.

On a specific query having been put to the counsel whether such reduction has already been made, counsel submits that even though an order to the prejudice of the petitioners has not been passed till date yet they apprehend that such action would be taken in the future as in the case of a similarly situated employee an order dated 25.05.2016 at Annexure P-5 has been passed.

The present petition is based on a mere apprehension. No order till date has been passed against the petitioners and which may be construed to entail adverse civil consequences.

The writ petition is clearly premature and is dismissed as such.
