Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner was initially appointed as Mali under the Haryana State Forest Department in the year 1988. Order dated 15.03.2016 at Annexure P-2 indicates that services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003. Counsel submits that in pursuance to such order even the consequential benefits have been granted. Short grievance raised in the petition is that in spite of the petitioner having been granted benefit of regularization in service w.e.f. 01.10.2003, yet the ACP scales on completion of requisite number of years of regular satisfactory service have been denied. Contention is that the petitioner would be entitled to the financial benefits envisaged under the Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules, 2008.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition itself in terms of issuing direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to consider the claim of the petitioner strictly in accordance with law and to decide the legal notice dated 25.05.2016 at Annexure P-5 by passing a well reasoned speaking order

within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
