The father of the petitioner while working as Lineman with the Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. (PSPCL) died in harness on 29.04.2006.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the claim of the legal heirs/petitioner for compassionate appointment in terms of the Policy dated 21.11.2002 has not yet been considered.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that his client would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents/competent authority to decide the claim of the petitioner for the aforesaid relief in a time bound manner.

The prayer is reasonable and is liable to be accepted without calling upon the other party.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the present case, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the

respondents/competent authority to decide the claim of the petitioner by passing a speaking order for grant of the compassionate appointment in terms of the Policy dated 21.11.2002, as set out in the Legal Notice dated 08.04.2016 (**Annexure P-3**), as also in the present writ petition within four months from the receipt of copy of the writ petition and certified copy of this order.

Disposed of in the above terms.
