On 28.01.2016 respondent-Ranjeet Kaur was personally present along with her counsel whereas appellant-Jugraj Singh was not present but his counsel was present. Ranjeet Kaur had made a statement on that day that at any cost she is not prepared to live with her husband-appellant and let the decree of divorce granted by the Trial Court in her favour be maintained and further she stated that she does not want any alimony, maintenance etc. from her husband-Jugraj Singh. Today appellant-Jugraj Singh is present along with his counsel. He has made a statement that he has gone through the statement made by Ranjeet Kaur-respondent on 28.1.2016 which is to the above effect. In view of the statement made by Ranjeet Kaur he states that let this appeal be dismissed as withdrawn. He has further stated that after marriage he had purchased land in the name of respondent-Ranjeet Kaur and he should be given liberty to challenge that sale deed for getting him back the land in accordance with law.

In view of the statement of appellant-Jugraj Singh the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforestated liberty permissible under the law.
