JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner is working as a Pump Driver with Municipal Council, Rupnagar-respondent no.2. He is claiming a direction for his promotion as Supervisor w.e.f. 29.12.2009 when his junior Gural Singh-Pump Driver was promoted; as also a direction granting him technical grade pay scale as per the recommendations of the third pay commission made applicable to the Board/Corporation w.e.f. 16.09.2002.

In separate written statement filed, it has been stated that the petitioner is not entitled to promotion as Supervisor as also grant of higher technical grade on account of he not having qualified the ITI Diploma/Certificate of 02 years from any institute as required in terms of the decision/notification of the government granting such scales.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for Municipal Council, Rupnagar, however, submits that subsequently a resolution no.49 dated 21.09.2015 has been passed ordering the grant of necessary relief to the petitioner. The same has been sent to the government for necessary approval.

Learned State Counsel assures the Court that a decision upon the aforesaid resolution no.49 in accordance with law would be taken and conveyed by the competent authority within a period of 06 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the State through their Counsel, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present writ petition be disposed of as infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The State of Punjab shall be bound by the aforesaid stand failing which Secretary, Local Government, Punjab would make himself liable for being hauled up in contempt proceedings
