The petitioner seeks consideration of her candidature for appointment as Lecturer in Hindi (School Cadre). Since she had been declared ineligible, she has filed the present petition challenging such action on the part of the State.

At the time of issuing notice of motion, this Court had provisionally allowed the petitioner to take part in the selection process. It was further directed that the result of the petitioner shall not be declared till further orders by this Court.

On the last date, I had directed the State to produce the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover. The same has been done, on the opening of which, it is found that the petitioner had secured 82 marks. Learned State counsel informs the Court that the last person selected and appointed in the General category i.e. the

category to which the petitioner belongs, has secured 132 marks.

In view of the aforesaid facts, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

The result of the petitioner be re-sealed and given back back to the learned State counsel.
