The petitioners, who are two in number, have filed a joint petition raising an apprehension that their contractual engagement at present may be terminated and they may be replaced by another similar arrangement.

Pleadings would indicate that both the petitioners were engaged in two different colleges.

Needless to observe that the relevant factors in the nature of work and conduct of the petitioners and the requirement/work load would be different in respect of separate institutions. As such, a joint writ petition at the hands of employees working in different institutions is neither proper nor appropriate.

Faced with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to file a petition afresh after meeting the observations and objection noticed in this order.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
