Petitioners seek the benefit of regularization from the date their juniors were regularized.

As per the written statement filed, apart from petitioner No.3, petitioners No.1, 2 & 4 have been regularized whereas petitioner No.3 has not been granted the said benefit as he is at Sr.No.143 and the services of the employees were to be regularized only upto seniority No.121. It is further averred that his case would be considered as per seniority, on his turn.

In such circumstances, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of, as such. However, petitioner No.3 will be at liberty to take recourse to further proceedings, in accordance with law, in case petitioner No.3 is not considered for seniority, on the due date, on his turn.
