Learned counsel for the State, at the very outset, submits that in view of the averments taken in preliminary objection No.1 and the testing reports, present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such.

The averments taken in para No.1 of the preliminary objections of written statement filed on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3, read as under: -

“That at the outset it is humbly submitted that the relief sought by the petitioner has already been fulfilled as the sample of the water of all the five tubewells of village Biajekan has been got checked from the Laboratory and accordingly the provisions of Haryana State Rural Water Policy, 2012 has been fully complied with. Copies of the reports of the Laboratory are annexed herewith as Annexure R-2/1 to R-2/5. It is further submitted that the water was got checked twice and Sub Divisional Engineer has also submitted the report as Junior Engineer has also done the needful i.e. illegal

running of the motors direct to the supply connection has been removed from the premises of Shri Ashok Kumar Grover son of Shri Darshan Lal 2) Shiv Lal son of Shri Hasna Ram (Panch) and 3) Prithvi Ram son of Shri Shadi Lal. Further the time of supply of drinking water has been fixed and all the leakage of 12 places have been repaired. A copy of the report of the Sub Divisional Engineer is annexed herewith as Annexure R-2/6.”

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that let the present writ petition be disposed of, in terms of the abovesaid stand taken on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

Ordered accordingly.
