Five petitioners namely Manohar Singh, Shashi Kumar, Nirmal Singh, Ashwani Kumar and Kashmir Singh stood retired w.e.f. 31.1.2015, 30.4.2012, 30.4.2012,30.9.2014 and 31.1.2015 respectively in the rank of Junior Engineer from the services of Municipal Corporation Amritsar/Ludhiana. They were claiming the benefit of grant of revision of pay scale and re-designation as Assistant Engineer in terms of the policy decision dated 1.12.2011(P-2).

Without even issuing notice the learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions.

At the time of hearing today, learned Deputy Advocate General states that the present writ petition has become infructuous in the light of order dated 6.8.2016 passed by the competent authority granting necessary relief.
