Surya Kant, J. (Oral)

The first petitioner is a Co-operative House Building Society while two other petitioners are its members. It is claimed that due to typographical mistake, one khasra number has wrongly been mentioned in the sale-deed of the Society vide which it purchased the land. It is further alleged that the khasra number which was actually sold to the Society inadvertently was recorded under the ownership of the Improvement Trust and has been further sold. On this premise, the petitioners seek exchange of khasra numbers as mentioned in the head note of the writ petition. A legal notice to this effect has already been served.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any views on the merits of the claim, we dispose of this writ

petition with a direction to the Improvement Trust, Ludhiana, to ascertain

the correct facts and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. However, in the event of any further dispute between the parties, the petitioners are relegated to the Civil Court.

Ordered accordingly.
