2. Counsel for Union of India fairly submitted that order dated
21.07.2016 is being complied today by paying costs of Rs. 5,000/- to the
petitioner's counsel to be paid to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents filed an affidavit along with the CM. The same is taken in the open Court.

4. Perusal of the affidavit, it is evident from Para 5 that the petitioner's grievance relating to grant of pension is under process. In view of the statement made in the affidavit by the Deputy Inspector General (N.W.) Frontier, Headquarter ITB Police Force Chandigarh, the present petition do not survive for consideration.

5. However the respondents are directed to complete the process of sanction of pension and disburse the pension to the petitioner within a period of two months from today.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that family pension was due to the petitioner in the year 2006 therefore she is entitled for interest. The respondents are directed to pay interest @ 9% per annum on arrears of pension to the petitioner within a period of four months from today.

Accordingly, Petition stands disposed of.
