After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedy before the appropriate forum, in accordance with the provisions contained in the Electricity Act, 2003. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it may be clarified that the order dated 18.03.2016 passed by the learned Permanent Lok Adalat may not come in the way of the petitioner.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

It deserves to be clarified that since the petitioner has been pursuing her remedy before the wrong forum under the bonafide wrong impression, the order dated 18.03.2016 passed by the learned Permanent Lok Adalat shall not come in the way of the petitioner. The authorities under the Electricity Act, 2003 shall consider the matter on its merits without having been influenced by the order dated 18.03.2016 passed by the learned

Permanent Lok Adalat and shall pass an appropriate order considering all the relevant facts and circumstances of the case and strictly in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
