Pleadings on record would indicate that petitioner was engaged as a part time Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar under the Respondent Education Department on 10.08.1996. His services have been regularized w.e.f. 01.04.2011.

Counsel submits that private respondent No.4 Azad Singh S/o Sh. Deep Singh was also engaged as part time Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar subsequently and three years later i.e. on 03.04.1999 yet his services have been regularized w.e.f. 01.03.2002.

The instant petition has been filed seeking parity as regards grant of benefit of regularization. Counsel submits that he would be satisfied if at this stage directions are issued to the respondent authorities to consider the claim of the petitioner seeking benefit of ante-dated regularization and w.e.f. 01.03.2002 in the light of a legal notice that has already been served.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it

appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider the claim of the petitioner strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order on the legal notice dated 21.10.2015 at Annexure P-6 within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
