This petition is filed by the institute who has not received the Scholarship fee payable for the students of SC/ST/OBC/BC category under the Post Matric Scholarship Scheme from the Session 2013-2014 onwards.

In this regard Kripa Shankar Saroj, Secretary, Punjab Government, Welfare Department, Chandigarh has submitted that the Scholarship has not been received from the Union of India. It is further submitted that as soon as the scholarship is received, it would be disbursed to the petitioner or to the colleges.

Union of India and the Government of Punjab may sort out their differences, if any, but insofar as Scholarship for the students of SC/ST/OBC/BC category is concerned, they are definitely entitled to the Post Matric Scholarship Scheme from the
