Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that during the pendency of the present writ petition, notification dated 11.7.2016 has been issued by Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission.

After going through the relevant provisions of the notification dated 11.7.2016 and particularly regulation 3.8 thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities by moving an appropriate representation within a period of one month from today and the respondent authorities may be directed to consider the grievance raised by the petitioner in his representation in accordance

with the provisions contained in the notification dated 11.7.2016 within a reasonable period.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the respondents also fairly states he is not averse to the proposal put by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the abovesaid respective stands taken by the learned counsel for the parties, instant writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities by moving an appropriate representation within a period of one month from today. The respondent authorities, whosoever is competent out of them, shall consider the grievance raised by the petitioner in his representation and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law and keeping in view the provisions contained in regulations 3.8 of the notification dated 11.7.2016, but in any case within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
