The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for restraining the respondents from demolishing the structure of the petitioners till the compliance of Section 3E of the National Highway Act, 1956, is made or in alternative respondent themselves keep the salvage and pay the compensation alongwith solatium to the petitioners which has been deducted towards the salvage value.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners has approached this Court without notice of the demand to the respondents. He prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a representation. However, a direction be issued to the respondents to decide the same expeditiously.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is observed that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided by the respondent-authority expeditiously in accordance with law.
