Petitioner-Smt. Amarjit Kaur was appointed as a Lecturer Punjabi with the Department of Education (Secondary School), Punjab with retrospective effect from 16.12.2006 i.e. the date from which candidates similarly situated had joined. Her pay was fixed on notional basis, however, the arrears for such notional fixation were to be extended w.e.f. the date of her actual joining 19.09.2008.

The precise grievance in the present petition was thus redressed. However, the arrears of the increased pay were not being granted.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel states that the required payment has since been made, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
