Application is disposed of. Documents at Annexures P-10 to P-14 are taken on record.

Main case:

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioners herein were engaged as Assistant Line Man on contractual basis in the month of November, 2011. Even though, their initial engagement was for six months period yet, they have been granted regular extensions and the last extension granted to them is upto 16.02.2017. Towards such submission, counsel has adverted to documents placed on record at Annexure P-13 on the subject of renewal of contract. Counsel submits that as per order dated 04.09.2014 issued by the Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and received under the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005, it would be clear that

the Haryana Government Notification dated 18.06.2014 on the subject of grant of benefit of regularization has been adopted by the respondent/Nigam.

Precise claim raised in the petition is that all the petitioners are clearly covered as regards benefit of regularization under the Haryana Government Notification dated 18.06.2014, yet, till date, their claim has not been considered and finalized.

Counsel states that even representations have been preferred and he would be satisfied, if at this stage, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent/Nigam to consider the same. Such request and submission is found to be fair.

Accordingly, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioners strictly in accordance with law and against the backdrop of the relevant regularization policy and to take a final decision on the representation dated 09.03.2016 and duly forwarded on 21.03.2016 at Annexure P-9 and by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
