TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The petitioner who is serving on the post of P.G.T. (History) has filed the instant petition assailing the action of the respondent/Department in having transferred him from Government Senior Secondary School, Kherli Lala, Sohana, District Gurgaon to Government Senior Secondary School, Panniwala Mota, Odhan, District Sirsa.

The primary submission raised by counsel is that the transfer of the petitioner has been directed in contravention of the transfer policy issued by the State Government vide memo dated 29.06.2016 at Annexure P-4. That apart, it has been submitted that the petitioner is presently pursuing his higher studies at University of Delhi and the transfer would affect his studies.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is of the considered view that no interference in the matter is called for.

Transfer is an incidence of service. Terms and conditions contained in a transfer policy do not vest an enforceable right. These are matters which need to be agitated before the employer/Competent Authority.

As such, while declining to interfere in the matter, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach Competent/State Authority as regards his grievance against the impugned order of transfer.

Disposed of.
