SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is Gram Panchayat of Village Longodeva, Tehsil Zira, District Ferozepur. It has secured the eviction order dated 8.5.2015 against the private respondents which has been passed by the Collector in exercise of powers under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961. The private respondents filed statutory appeal and got an order of status quo. The Appellate Authority has vacated the said *ad interim* stay on 18.9.2015. The appeal is still pending. The Gram Panchayat seeks a direction to the official respondents for implementation of the eviction order. In our considered view, there is a remedy of execution

available to the Gram Panchayat and if it files the same, the Executing Court is directed to decide the proceedings promptly and in accordance with law.
