Counsel would submit that the petitioner was engaged as a Gun Man on 12.1.2001 with the Haryana State Cooperative Supply and Marketing Federation Ltd. (HAFED). Services of the petitioner having been terminated in August, 2001, an industrial dispute was raised and the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat rendered award dated 18.2.2003 holding the petitioner entitled for reinstatement with continuity of service along with full back wages. It is contended that the petitioner has been working continuously up to date.

Grievance raised in the present petition is that inspite of claim of the petitioner for grant of benefit of regularization being covered under Govt. Policies dated 18.6.2014 (Annexure P-2) as also dated 7.7.2014 (Annexure P-3), yet, no final decision has been taken.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the present petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order on the legal notice dated 13.7.2015 (Annexure P-4) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition disposed of.
