This petition is filed in order to challenge the order passed by the District Food Supplies Controller, Ambala followed by the order of the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala dismissing the appeal of the petitioner, filed in terms of Clause 16 of the Haryana Public Distribution System (Licensing and Control) Order, 2009. It is alleged that there were 119 complaints against the petitioner out of which 100 have been found false and on the basis of 19 other complaints, which are primarily of the irregularity on the part of the petitioner in opening the ration depot in time, order has been passed for cancellation of the ration depot.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record with his able assistance and found that the issue involved in this case is essentially of a civil nature as the petitioner has to lead evidence to prove that

the finding recorded by both the authorities under the Statute are factually incorrect.

In view of that matter, the petitioner is relegated to his remedy of civil suit, which may be filed, if so advised.
