Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner approached this Court seeking a direction to respondent no.2 to migrate the petitioner in 3rd Semester of B.A. LLB. (Hons.) (5 years Integrated Course) from Hoshiarpur Campus to Ludhiana Campus.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that along with the petitioner some other students have applied seeking migration from Hoshiarpur Campus to Ludhiana Campus. In case migration is to be granted, the same has to be as per the merit.

It is not in dispute that the curriculum of the course is same, as both the Campus are governed under the Panjab University. Hence, the fact that there is some delay in grant of migration because of inaction on the part of the University initially and thereafter because of pendency of the present writ petition in this Court will not be fatal. Once the seats were available in 3rd Semester and consequently in the 4th Semester, the University is directed to hold counselling for migration of the applicants, who applied for migration to Ludhiana Campus from Hoshiarpur Campus, as per the policy of the University and subject to availability of the seats. Let the needful be done within a period of ten days.

The petition stands disposed of.
