TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The petitioner who is a Medical Officer and a member of the Haryana Civil Medical Services has filed the instant writ petition being aggrieved of her transfer from Civil Hospital, Rohtak to Civil Hospital, Faridabad.

Learned senior counsel would vehemently argue that the petitioner's specialization is in the field of radiology and there is no work available at Faridabad and as such, the transfer would not serve any purpose. He would submit that it is not only a case of simple transfer but would also entail wastage of public money.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, I am of the considered view that no intervention is called for.

These are matters which need to be agitated before the respondent-department/employer in the first instance. As such, while declining to interfere in the matter, liberty is granted to the petitioner to pursue the matter before the respondent as regards her grievance against the impugned transfer.

Petition is dismissed.
