The issue raised in this petition is that both the petitioners got married against the wishes of the parents of petitioner No.2 and are afraid that her parents may not interfere in their married life and also cause them physical harm. In order to protect their life and liberty, the petitioners had approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala with an application alleging that they have got married on 5.8.2016 in a temple at Panchkula with their own free will and consent but the family members of petitioner No.2 are against their marriage. The petitioners have thus prayed that an appropriate direction may be issued to the SSP, Patiala to ensure the protection of their life and liberty, particularly threatened by respondents No.4 to 6.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the facts mentioned in the petition, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the

petitioners raised by way of representation dated 9.8.2016 and in case any threat is being given by respondents No.4 to 6, appropriate action be taken in accordance with law.
