Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent, petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is seeking only a writ in the nature of mandamus and her self-contained legal notice dated 01.12.2015 (Annexure P-11) is pending consideration before the respondent.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the State also fairly states that let the present writ petition be disposed of, with a direction to the respondent to take appropriate decision on the legal notice already served by the petitioner vide Annexure P-11.

In view of the abovesaid statements made by learned counsel for the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to Financial Commissioner and Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Rehabilitation Department, Chandigarh-respondent to consider the grievance raised by the petitioner in her legal notice dated 01.12.2015 (Annexure P-11) and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order therein, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
