Challenge has been raised in the present writ petition to the summons dated 24.06.2016 (Annexure P6), sent by the respondent-Commission, whereby the case was fixed for hearing on 27.07.2016. It is not disputed that now, the proceedings are pending for 23.08.2016.

Counsel submits that the issue of jurisdiction arises and has placed reliance upon the judgment of the Apex Court in **Thalappalam Ser. Coop. Bank Ltd. & others Vs. State of Kerala & others 2013 (16) SCC 82.**

Since the petitioner-Society has only been put to notice, it will always be open to it to raise all the objections before the respondent-Commission, as to whether its case falls within the parameters, as defined by the Apex Court.

Faced with this situation, counsel does not press the present writ petition and prays to withdraw the same, with the aforesaid liberty.

Ordered accordingly.
