The petitioner seeks correction of date of birth as “23.06.1989” instead of “15.03.1989” in the certificates issued by respondent-Board on 30.10.2007 and 4.1.2010 (Annexures P/2 and P/3 respectively). The name of the father is also sought to be changed as 'Hisham Singh' instead of 'Isham Singh' in the said certificates. Reliance has been placed upon the certificate (Annexure P/1) issued by the Registrar, Births and Deaths containing correct details which was registered on 4.7.1989.

It is the case of the petitioner that representation dated 2.8.2016 (Annexure P/4) has been filed with the respondent-Board for the necessary relief but no action has been taken. Resultantly, the present writ petition has been filed.

Notice was issued to the Board which has been duly served upon it. However, none has put in appearance on behalf of the Board.

Keeping in view the fact that the representation dated 2.8.2016 (Annexure P/4) is pending consideration and decision on it is still to be taken, the Court is of the opinion that it is appropriate if the respondent-

Board is directed to take action on the above said representation and decide the claim of the petitioner as per its Regulations within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.

In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the respondent-Board and be conveyed to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
