The petitioner is a Society which has prayed for direction to respondent No.2 to conduct a fair inquiry and take appropriate action against respondent No.4, who has cut the old trees without prior permission of the Department.

It is conceded position that respondent No.4 was charge-sheeted on the same allegations and has been exonerated by respondent No.2, vide his order dated 4th March, 2016. Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to bring on record the material to challenge the order dated 4th March, 2016 by which respondent No.4 has been exonerated. Even otherwise, the impugned order dated 4th March, 2016 has to be challenged under the relevant rules and not by way of a writ petition.

Consequently, I do not find any merit in the present petition. The same is hereby dismissed.
