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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner-Company has filed the present civil writ petition for issuing a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent-Bank not to release the payment against letter of credit (LC No. 50587161M0000081, dated 27.4.2016), issued by respondent No. 1 in favour of respondent No. 2.

It comes out that the petitioner-Company had already filed a civil suit for permanent injunction, which is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) Chandigarh. It shows that the petitioner-Company has already availed the remedy before the Civil Court. Therefore, the writ before this Court for the same relief does not lie. If the petitioner-Company is aggrieved and its injunction application is not being decided, it can always make a request to the lower Court or seek appropriate remedy.
