The petitioners, who claim themselves to be residents of villages Garopar and Aur, Tehsil and District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, have filed the present petition with a grievance that some residents of the village are being falsely implicated in NDPS Act cases. Direction has been sought for proper enquiry and also to take action against the guilty police officials.

The persons who, according to the petitioners, have been falsely implicated have no grievance as nothing has been mentioned on record as to whether they had raised a grievance before any authority regarding their false implication. The petitioners have not been able to show as to what are their credentials to invoke the jurisdiction of this court by filing Public Interest Litigation. No general direction can be given in

criminal case, as each case depends on its own facts. If any material is

available with any accused, he can very well produce the same before the Investigating Officer showing that he has been falsely implicated. No Public Interest Litigation can be entertained for this purpose.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
