Feeling aggrieved against the alleged repeated cancellation of the auction proceedings, petitioners have approached this Court by way of present writ petition seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent authorities to conduct the auction without any further cancellation.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is not in dispute that petitioners have been allowed to participate in the auction proceedings. Petitioners can claim only that much right. It is not even the pleaded or argued case on behalf of the petitioners that they were denied any participation as and when the auction notice was issued.

The prayer made by the petitioners in the writ petition has been found wholly misconceived, which cannot be granted at the hands of this Court, while exercising its writ jurisdiction under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the above, no case for interference has been made out.

Dismissed.
