Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that although the petitioners are seeking only a writ in the nature of mandamus, yet they did not approach the respondent authorities by moving an appropriate representation or legal notice before filing the present writ petition. She further submits that given an opportunity, petitioners shall approach the respondent authorities within a period of three weeks by moving an appropriate representation and respondent No.3 may be directed to consider and decide the same, by passing an appropriate order at an early order.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the instant writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, S.A.S. Nagar

(Mohali)-respondent No.3, that if the petitioners approach him by way of an appropriate representation within a period of three weeks from today, he shall consider and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law and also keeping in view two orders passed by this Court at Annexures P-7 and P-8, i.e. CWP No.4847 of 2012 and CWP No.23932 of 2015, decided on 09.01.2015 and 24.02.2016, respectively, but in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioners.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
