The petitioner has questioned the validity of the order dated 19.8.2013 (Annexure P-5) and order dated 24.8.2013 (Annexure P-7) by which her services have been transferred out of Chandigarh.

While ordering notice of motion, stay had been granted. By virtue of interim order, she has been continued at Chandigarh till date.

The transfer of the petitioner is in the public interest as the unit where she is working itself was shifted from Chandigarh to Istingri (High Altitude Area). The petitioner being female has been accommodated in Jammu Tawi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since the petitioner is working in Chandigarh by virtue of interim order, she may be accommodated till 31.3.2017.

Accordingly, respondents are directed not to displace the petitioner till 31.3.2017.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
