2. Mr. Anil Chawla, Advocate, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Union of India.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to furnish 3 sets of writ papers to learned counsel for the respondent, during the course of the day.

4. With the consent of both the counsels, the present petition is disposed at the preliminary stage of the case.

5. The petitioner has sought for direction to the concerned respondent to correct/change the name as per the records supplied by the petitioner namely "Kuldeep Kumar Yadav" instead of "Yadav Kuldeep

Kumar Hukam Singh”. In respect of correction of his name he has submitted representation dated 15.09.2015 vide Annexure P3. In support of correction of his name he has furnished documents like Pan Card, Aadhaar Card, Voter Card, Ration Card and all his educational qualification certificates. In all those documents his name has been shown as “Kuldeep Kumar Yadav” whereas in the discharge book it has been shown as “Yadav Kuldeep Kumar Hukam Singh”.

6. In view of these facts and circumstances, the petitioner seeks to correct his name in the discharge book vide Annexure P-2 as well as in the Pension Payment Order (Annexure P1) from “Yadav Kuldeep Kumar Hukam Singh” to “Kuldeep Kumar Yadav”. If the records are genuine the respondents are directed to carry out the correction in Annexure P1 and P2 within a period of two months from today to enable him to get service benefits.

7. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
