Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondents authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Notice of motion was issued and in compliance thereof, written statement on behalf of the respondents was filed.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

So far as claim of the petitioners for allotment of land is concerned, it has gone undisputed. Respondents, in para 16 of their written statement, have clarified that land measuring 40 kanal was allotted to father of the petitioners vide order dated 31.08.1992. However, Form US-3 could not be issued in favour of the petitioners. No reason, whatsoever, has been assigned by the respondents as to why the needful could not be done so far.

In view of the abovesaid undisputed fact situation obtaining on the record of the case, Prescribed Authority-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (Civil),

Gurgaon-respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and ensure issuance of Form US-3 in favour of the petitioners without any further loss of time and in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Let the needful be done by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
