The petitioner has approached this Court being apprehensive that having been appointed as Guest Faculty Lecturer in Mathematics, he will not be re-employed at the start of the academic session in July, 2016. In the written statement filed today, the defence taken is that the petitioner is not NET qualified and if no other NET qualified candidate is available, the petitioner would be allowed to re-join the next academic session. The relevant para. of the affidavit filed by the Principal of the College reads as under : -

“6. That guest faculty lecturers cannot be supplanted by another set of guest faculty lecturers at the drop of the hat. Replacement would be only for good and sufficient cause i.e. subject to fulfillment of eligibility and availability of work. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not NET qualified and if, NET qualified is not available, the petitioner would be allowed to re-join from the next academic session.”

In view of the above undertaking, the present writ petition is disposed of by binding the respondents to the same.
