G.S.SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral)

The prayer in the present writ petition is to issue direction to the respondents to immediately hold and conduct the Ist Year and 2nd Year examinations of the Nursing College students belonging to batch 2014-15 and 2015-16 in the first and second years ANM & GNM Courses and declare the date sheet and to conduct the examination and declare the result. Direction was also sought to issue Detailed Marks Cards and Degrees whose result were declared in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court in **CWP No.21496 of 2015-Dr. Jai Parkash Sharma Memorial School of Nursing College and others Vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 8.10.2015 (Annexure P/1).

In the reply filed by the respondents, it has been pleaded that

date sheet for the supplementary examination for Ist and 2nd year of ANM and GNM and 3rd year annual examination for the batch of 2012-13 GNM/ANM students had already been issued by respondent no.5-University. The Ist year examination belonging to batch 2013-14 for ANM and GNM Training Courses were conducted in November, 2014 by the then Controller of Examination, Haryana State Medical Education Society, O/o Director, Medical Education & Research, Haryana. Thereafter, in the meeting which was held on 1.3.2016 under the Chairmanship of the then ACSMER, it was decided that the Controller of Examination of respondent no.5-University shall undertake all the work related to conduct of examination. Regarding the delay in conduct of examination the explanation given was that due to delayed submission of examination forms by the concerned Nursing Institutes to the competent authority, the same had been occurred. Date sheet for 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 for MPHWF/ANM/GNM date sheet had already been issued. It has further submitted that when the complete examination forms would be submitted by the institutes, the date sheet for Ist year ANM & GNM Courses for the session 2015-16 would be issued by the respondent no.5-University.

Regarding issue of DMCs, it was mentioned that work regarding printing of Detailed Mark Sheets (DMCs) of the 2013-14 batch had also been assigned to M/s Sarthak Data Solution Pvt. Ltd., Delhi and the same would be issued to the students in near future.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous to the extent of issuance of direction to hold the said examinations as part of it has been done and the

rest is in progress. The State shall accordingly ensure that the students of the 2015-16 batch will give their examination by December, 2016. It is further directed that respondents shall ensure that the Detailed Mark Sheets (DMCs) shall be supplied to the students of 2013-14 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition is disposed of.
