At the time of notice of motion, the following order was
passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 03.09.2015

*“Places reliance upon the pendency of CWP
No.17828 of 2015, pending for 08.09.2015.*

Notice of motion.

*To be heard along with CWP No.17828 of
2015 on 08.09.2015.*

*In the meantime, operation of the impugned
order dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-5) shall
remain stayed, to the extent that the
petitioner-Institute will not be required to
deposit the fine imposed and will be*

permitted to participate in the admission process, to the extent of the original seats, for which, the recognition/affiliation was granted. However, the Institute shall comply with the other directions, issued vide order dated 21.08.2015.

It is, however, made clear that this order is purely provisional and the admission done shall be subject to the final decision of the writ petition.”

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondents has produced the order passed in CWP No.17828 of 2015, which has been disposed of vide order dated 25.2.2016.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that since, the petitioner has relied upon the notice issued in CWP No.17828 of 2015, therefore, he has to sink and swim with the same. It is also submitted that the present petition may be disposed of in terms of the order passed in CWP No.17828 of 2015 dated 25.2.2016.

Ordered accordingly.
