The petitioner approached this Court for release of honorary pension to freedom fighter from the Central Pool by claiming that her husband was a freedom fighter.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submitted that the record pertaining to the husband of the petitioner could not be traced out. In case, State of Haryana provides them all the requisite documents relating to husband of the petitioner, the case shall be considered as per the scheme.

Learned State counsel submitted that the case of the husband of the petitioner was earlier recommended to the Government of India for grant of pension. However, still another set of requisite documents will be sent to the concerned department within two weeks.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 further submitted after receipt of the documents from the State of Haryana, claim of the petitioner

for release of honorary pension to the freedom fighters shall be considered in terms of the scheme and if she is found entitled to the pension, the amount shall be released within a period three months.

The petition is disposed of in the above-said terms.
