SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

- (1) In the instant case, the award was passed on 04.11.2011. Obviously the minimum period of five years did not expire before the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 came into force w.e.f. 01.01.2014.
- (2) In this view of the matter, Section 24(2) is inapplicable.
- (3) However, if the petitioner has any separate cause of action in respect of the acquired property, he may initiate independent proceedings.
- (4) With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition stands dismissed.
