SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to accept his request for discharge from the duties with effect from 16.12.2013 (Annexure P1) on account of family problems.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had submitted request, Annexure P1 to respondent No.3 for his discharge from service due to family problems but no action has been taken on the same so far.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of this case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to dispose of the request, Annexure P1 made by the petitioner for his discharge from service due to family problems expeditiously in accordance with law.
